

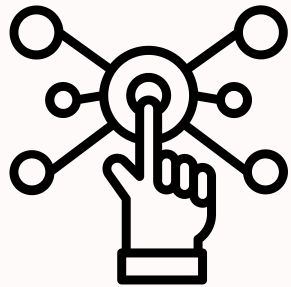
CHALLENGES OF OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE WITHIN THE ENERGY SECTOR

Challenge No. 1: Oversight of significant projects

The presence of multiple suppliers, subcontractors, and regulatory agencies presents an additional challenge for managing construction sites within the sector.

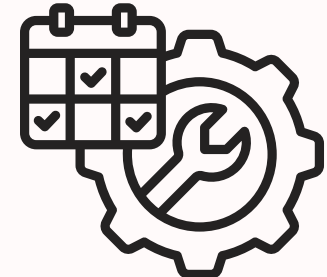


Challenge No. 2: Digitalization Remains Inadequate

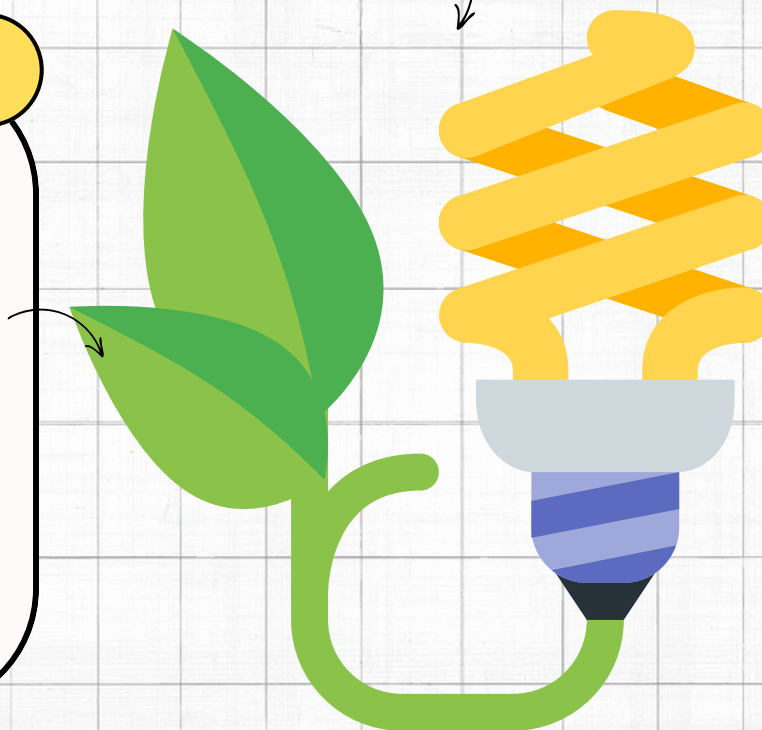


Fewer than one-third of the companies surveyed utilize digital tools that influence operational execution, representing nearly half the number found in other sectors, such as the automotive industry.

Challenge No. 3: Dependability and upkeep of infrastructures



In France in 2022, primary energy production experienced a decline of 17.9%. This reduction is primarily attributed to a decrease in the operational capacity of nearly half of the national nuclear fleet due to maintenance activities.



Initiatives by industry leaders



The digitalization of kanbans and visual management has enhanced flexibility and collaboration among geographically dispersed teams that previously needed to convene in person two to three times per quarter.
